What is Amazon A+ Content?



Amazon A+ Content is your key to standing out on the world's largest online marketplace. It enhances your product listings with eye-catching visuals and engaging text, highlighting your brand's unique features.

Key Benefits:

- Boosts Appeal: Makes your products more attractive to shoppers.
- Builds Trust: Helps establish credibility with potential buyers.
- Drives Sales: Increases conversion rates by showcasing your brand effectively.

General Content Guidelines for Amazon A+ Content





Text and Grammar Standards

Spelling & Punctuation: Use Oxford commas and spell out numbers under 10.

Capitalization: Capitalize major words in headers.

Consistency: Avoid inconsistent punctuation, grammar

mistakes, and excessive font styles like bold text.

Prohibited Content:

- No pricing, promotional information, or holiday references.
- Avoid mentioning shipping details or comparing competitors.
- Steer clear of time-sensitive terms like "latest" or "new."
- Do not reference off-Amazon customer service or provide contact details.




Image and Text Formatting

Image Quality Requirements:

File Types: Acceptable formats are .jpg, .bmp, .png (use RGB colorspace only).

Resolution: Minimum 72 dpi, file size under 2 MB. Ensure images are clear—avoid blurriness, watermarks, or unreadable text (especially for mobile users).

Unique Visuals for A+:

A+ images must be original and not reused from your main image gallery.





Accessibility and Alt-Text Requirements

Every image should include alt-text (maximum 100 characters). that accurately describes the image for screen readers. Make sure the alt-text is clear and useful for visually impaired users to prevent content rejection.



Brand Logos and Partner Symbols

Include one brand logo per A+ Content. Partner logos can be added if relevant but avoid cluttering with unnecessary symbols.



Claims, Certifications, and Awards

Awards: Only mention awards from the last two years, including the awarding body and date.

Certifications: Must be backed by evidence, specifying the certifying body and year.

Prohibited Claims:

- Avoid satisfaction guarantees or claims like "#1 rated" or "best-selling."
- Environmental claims (e.g., "eco-friendly") require full substantiation.







Content Restrictions and Policy Violations

Prohibited Content: No warranty information or claims to treat medical conditions, and no references to criminal activities.

Hyperlinks: Do not include links to external websites.

Trademark Usage: Keep TM and © symbols small and relevant to packaging or logos.



Submission and Review

Follow Amazon's content review process to ensure all text, images, and claims comply with their guidelines to avoid rejection.

These guidelines help ensure your A+ Content meets Amazon's standards and enhances your product's appeal, driving engagement and sales.



Small Dogs

Small dogs make better icons, because they are used to small spaces. Small collars, small bowls, small bods, small icons. It just fits. Big dogs don't always look good in small icons, because they are used to bigger spaces. Be sure to you add appropriate images based on the space.



Big Dogs

You can still add big dogs to small icons, but make sure the customer can see the details you are trying to highlight in the image. In some cased, if the image doesn't have enough details and the customer might end up buying a cat rather than a dog.



Sense of Smell
